 - Windows Server infrastructure customers






SD Card Encryption

Strengthened security

Updated: Wipro Total Cost of Ownership Analysis Microsoft

- Wipro Technologies examined the TCO of RIM vs. Windows Mobile in May 2007
 - Collected data from 162 Enterprise in US and EMEA
 - Test lab ran both solutions, verifying field results
- Windows Mobile TCO 20-28% lower than RIM
 - Less infrastructure, fewer components, lower support, better scalability
 - RIM users per exchange server maxed at 3,750, compared to WM of 7,500
 - 89% of RIM deployments survived used OWA, showcasing its acceptance

Introducing: System Center Mobile Device Manager

Helps IT Pro manage Windows Mobile phones like laptops and PCs

Manages security for sensitive corporate data and compliance on Windows Mobile phones, all in a single environment

Enables increased access to information with a single point, behind the firewall access to corporate data and applications

Core Feature Areas

System Center Mobile Device Manager will enable Windows Mobile phones to be deployed and managed (device and security) like PCs and laptops in the IT infrastructure, providing network access to corporate data
