



Windows® Phone 7 security & management

Helps protect corporate information	Exchange ActiveSync (EAS) Password policies Remote Wipe No PC tethered access or removable storage
Helps ensure data reliability	Application sandboxing prevents apps from sharing resources Marketplace certification enhance integrity Internet Explorer helps protect against malicious code from web sites
Enables secure data transmission	SSL Encryption (128/256 bit)
Supports secure access to SharePoint	Unified Access Gateway (UAG)-enabled access or SharePoint

Microsoft ActiveSync support

Password required	Locks phone when detects password requirement, except for emergency calls. Password must be set up in order to unlock the phone.
Minimum password length	Delivers error message if password is less than minimum length
Idle timeout frequency/value	Enables timeout lengths of up to 5 minutes
Device wipe threshold	Warns user before maximum number of password attempts; wipes device on last attempt
Allow simple password	Prevents user from setting up a password with the same delta between consecutive characters
Password expiration	Reminds users to change password before expiration. After date, locks device until password is changed
Password history	Tracks all passwords, preventing user from using same password twice

Configuration baseline Fewer complexities

- Synchronization of email
 - Only over the air or over Wi-Fi
 - Not available over local workstation
- Limit accepted devices with certificate
- Data transmission
 - Only over the air or over Wi-Fi
 - No Bluetooth or IrDA for data transmission
 - No removable storage cards
 - UAG uses roles based publishing and filtering
- Private APN configurable



Application Model Built-in Protection

- Managed code only
- Principle of minimal privilege
- Application signing
- Certification and verification
- Marketplace distribution
- Application are "sandboxed"
- No Background processing for 3rd party apps
- Internet Explorer Mobile isolation
- Application Data encryption
